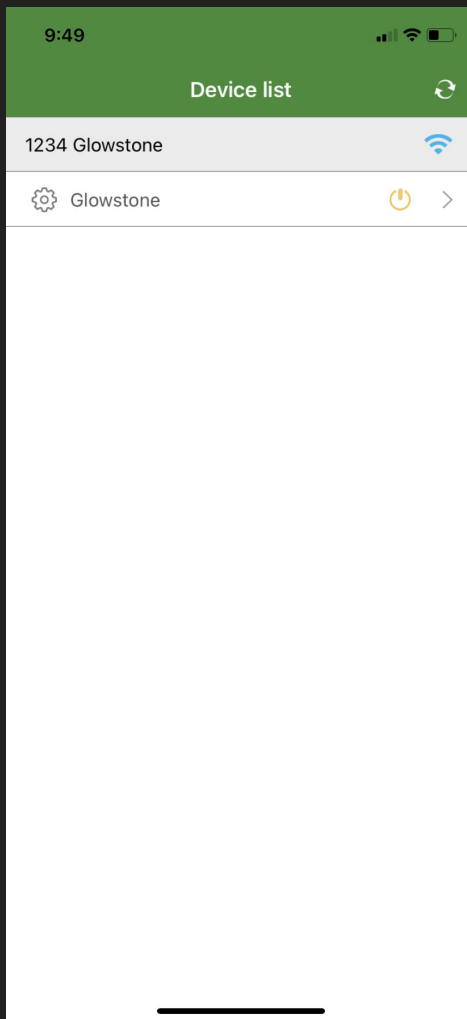
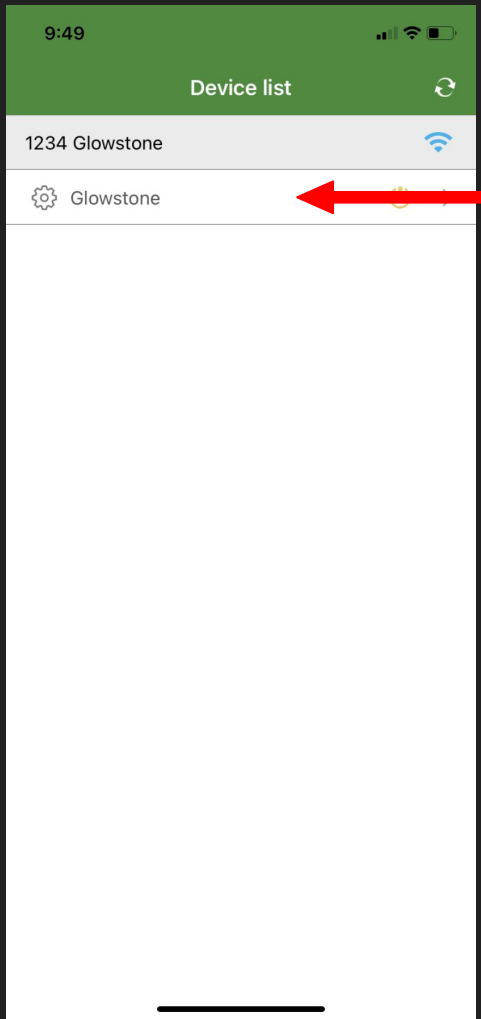


Making a Oilers Effect in the Skydance App

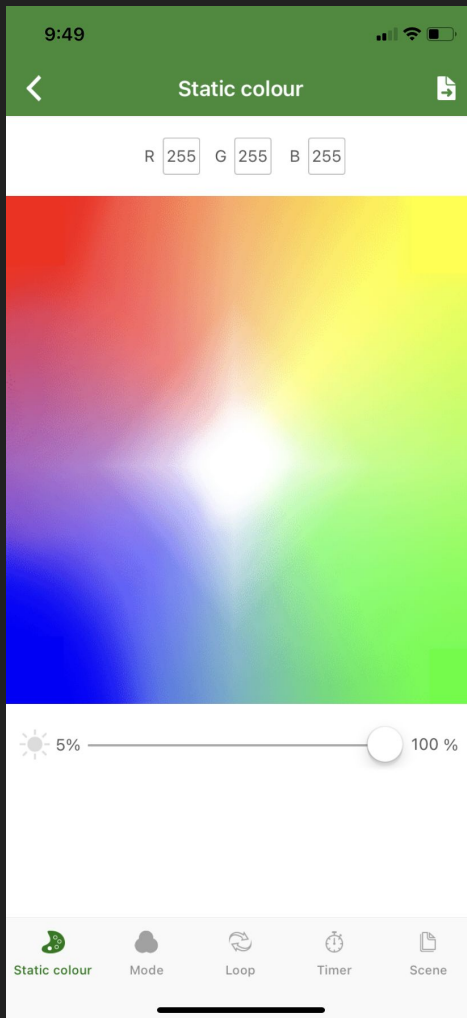
This is the first page you will see when you enter the skydance app.



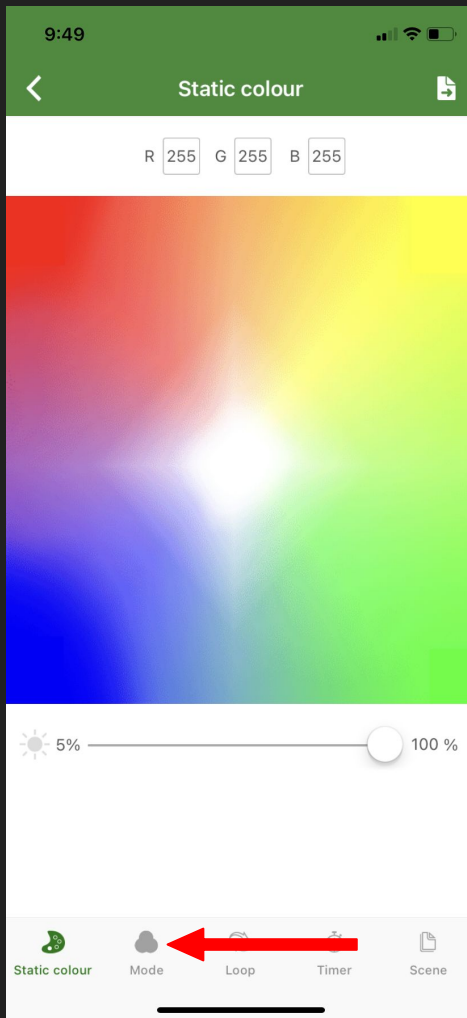


Click anywhere on this bar to begin customizing your lights.

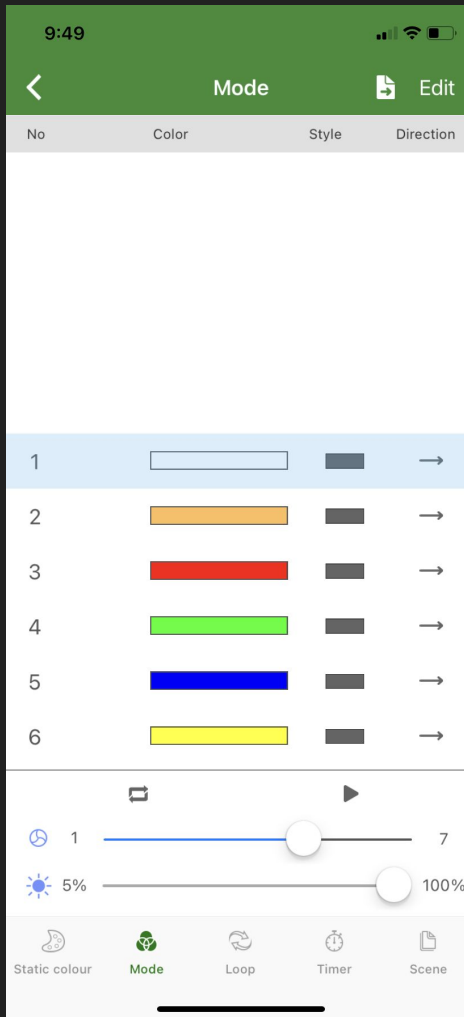
Doing this will take you to the “Static colour” page.



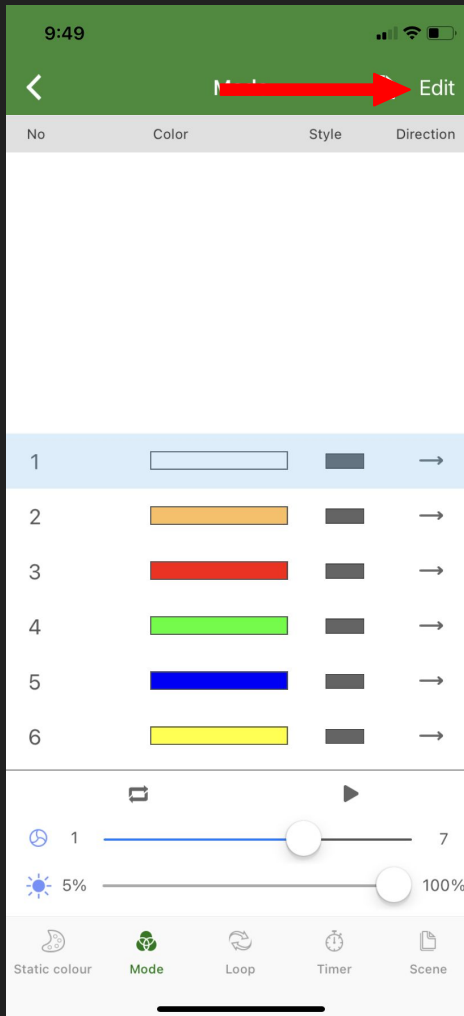
Click on the “Mode” icon on the bottom toggle bar.



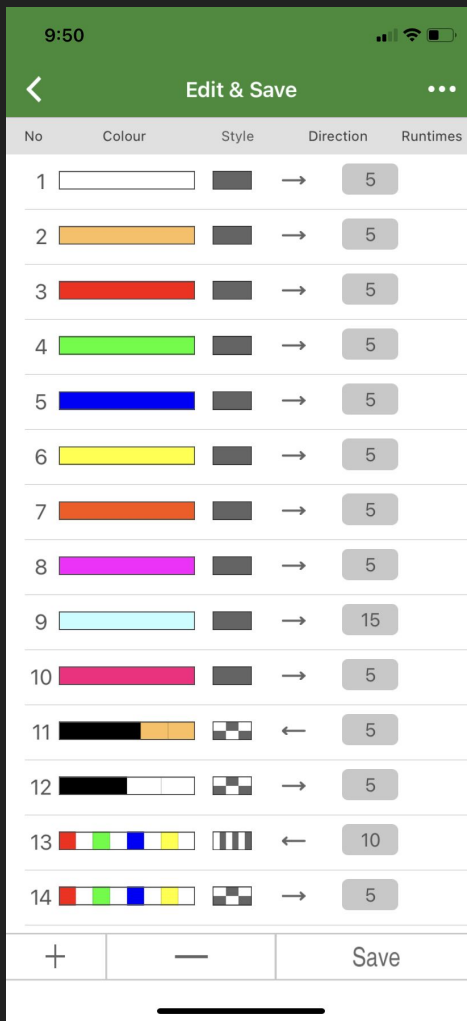
Now you are on the “Mode” page.



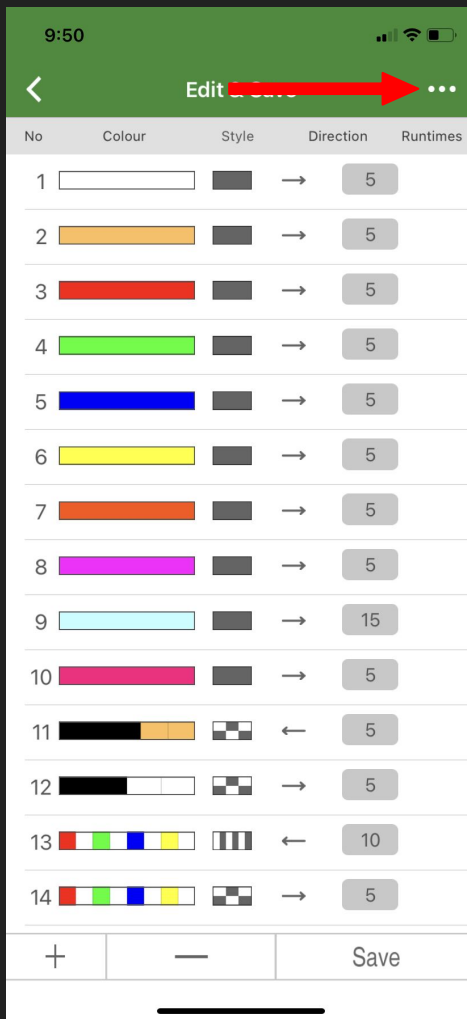
Click “Edit” in the top right corner.

Click on the 3 dots in the top right corner.



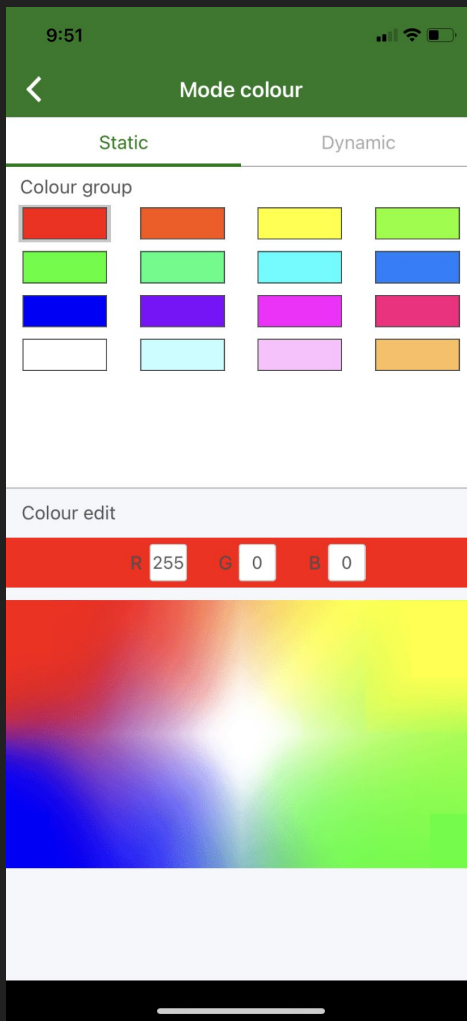
There will be a drop down with 4 options

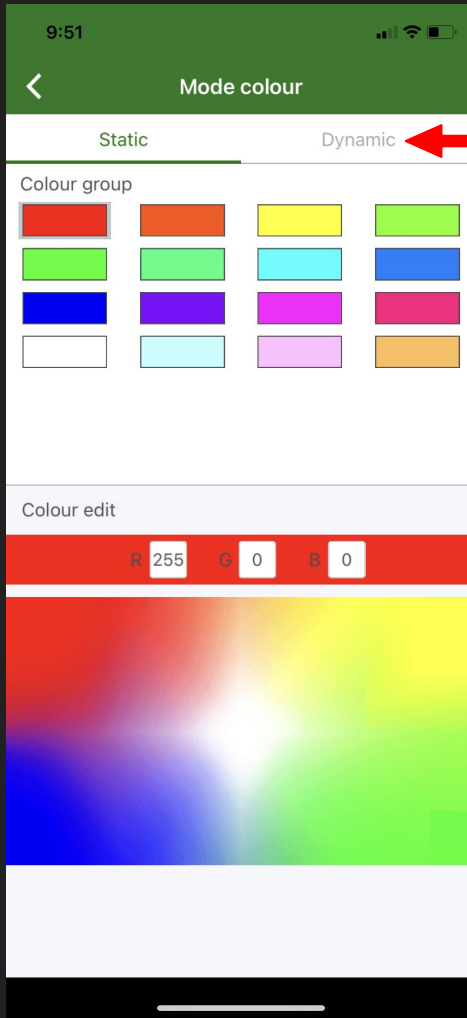


Choose "Edit Color"



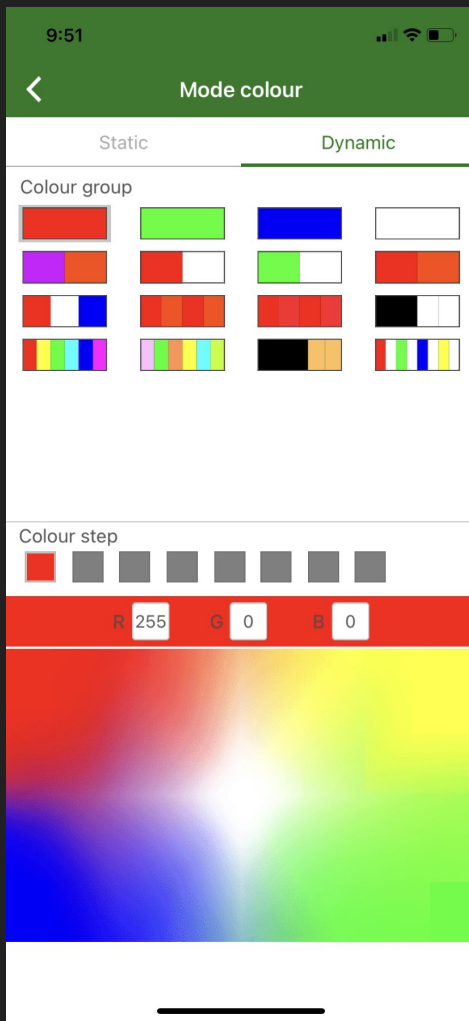
Now you are on the static portion of the “Mode colour” page

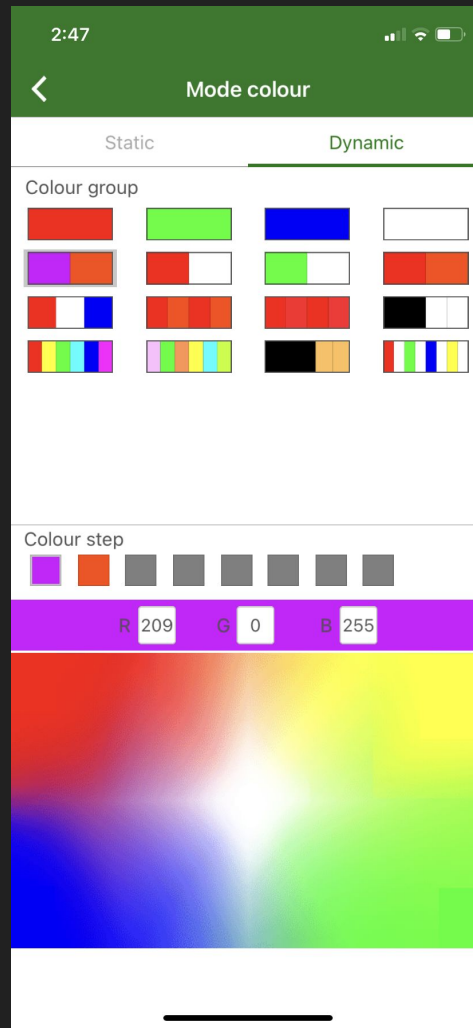




Click on "Dynamic"

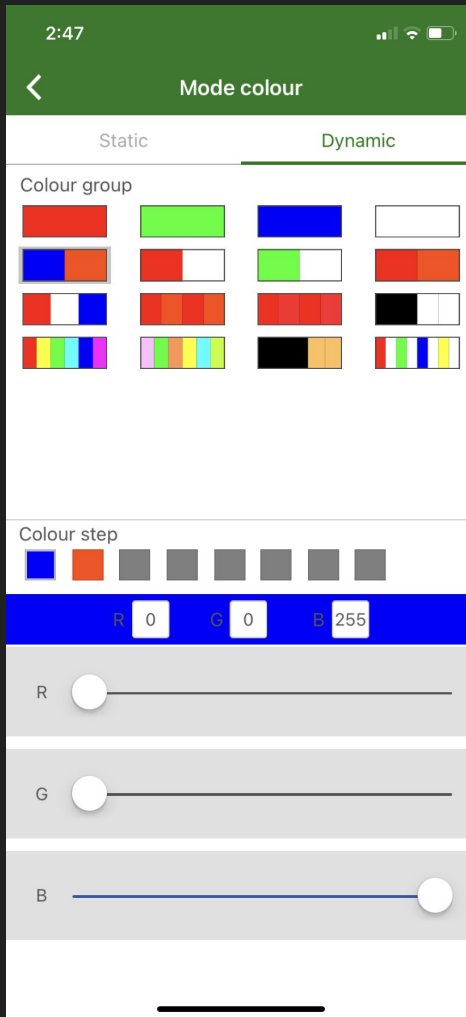
Now you are on the dynamic portion of the “Mode colour” page. From here you can edit any of these colour combinations.



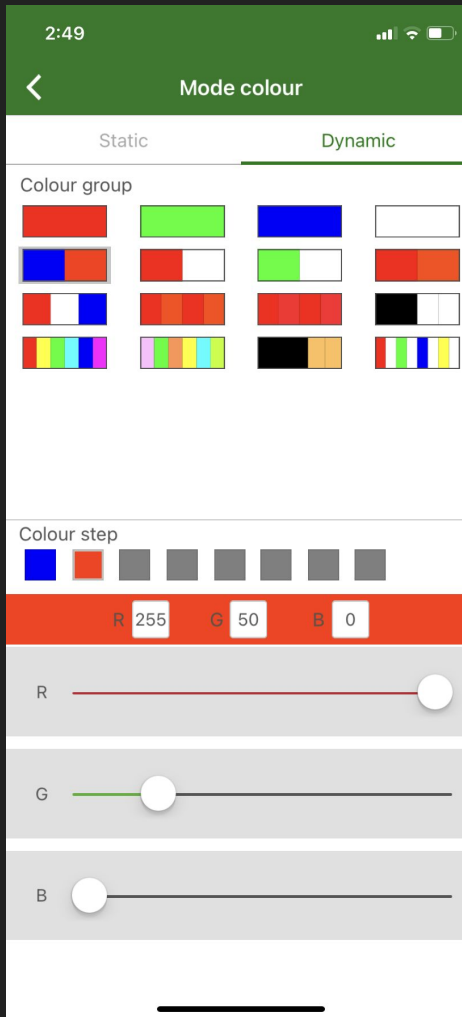


Select one of the 2 color options

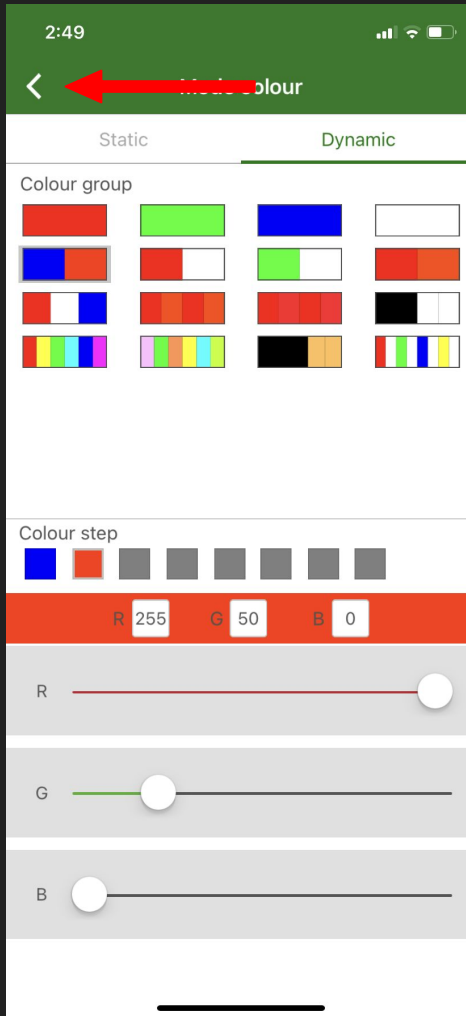
Change the first color to be blue by changing the RGB code to R(0), G(0), B(255).

Go back by clicking this arrow





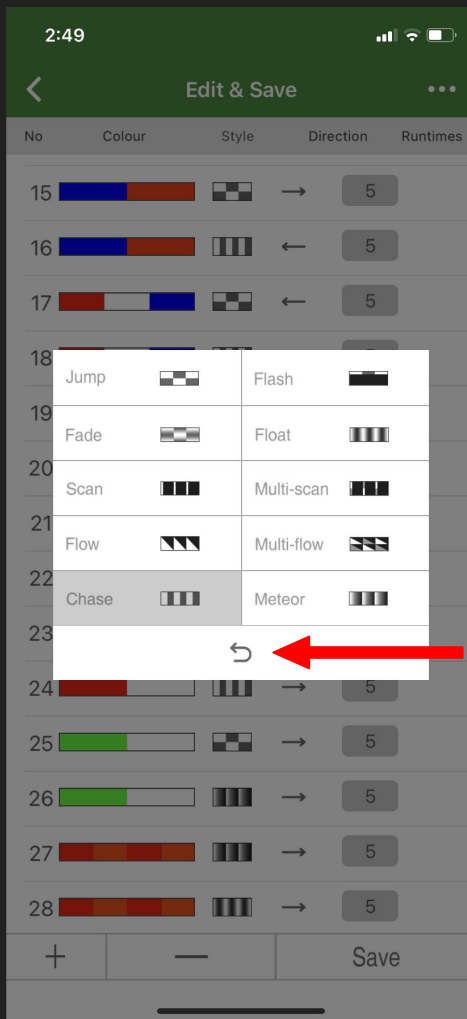
