


Creating Pot Light Effects in the Skydance App

This is the first page you will see when you enter the skydance app.





Click anywhere on this bar to begin customizing your lights.





Doing this will take you to the "Static colour" page.






Click on the "Mode" icon on the bottom toggle bar.











Now you are on the "Mode" page.






Click "Edit" in the top right corner.

Now you are on the "Edit & Save" page. We will need to go one step further to edit colours.






Click on the 3 dots in the top right corner.






There will be a drop down with 4 options






Choose "Edit Color"





Now you are on the static portion of the "Mode colour" page





Click on "Dynamic"





Now you are on the dynamic portion of the "Mode colour" page. From here you can edit any of these colour combinations.






We will select this color combination to change into pot lights.






First, change all the squares to black by changing the RGB codes to 0, 0, 0






Now create the pot light effect that you want, We will go through a few examples.

This one would be 1 light off one light on.






The patterns will always read from left to right and any black squares at the back of the pattern will not register. You can clearly see this here.






This would be 2 lights off, 1 light on.






This would be 3 lights off, 1 light on.






This would be 3 lights off, 2 lights on.






This would be 3 lights off, 3 lights on.






This would be 7 lights off, 1 light on.






Once you have the desired pot light effect go back to the previous page.






Now we need to change the pot lights to a jump pattern or they will not appear as pot lights on your home. To do this click here to edit the style.






Now select "jump" and then back.





Now that you see the pot lights have the "jump" style you can click "save".





Wait for it to say load success and then go back. If it doesn't say load success then try again.





Now on the "mode" page you will be able to find the pot light effect that you have created.
