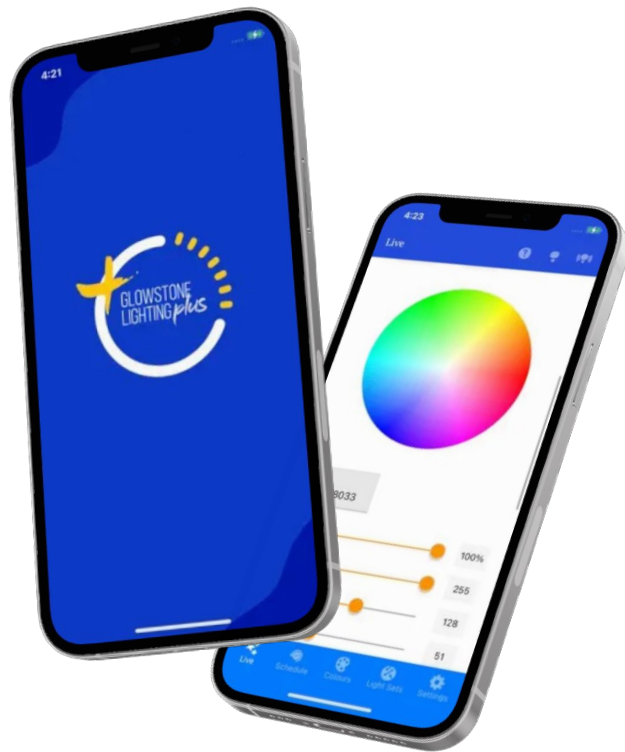


How To

Create Colour Palettes with Dim Colours

On the Glowstone Lighting Plus App



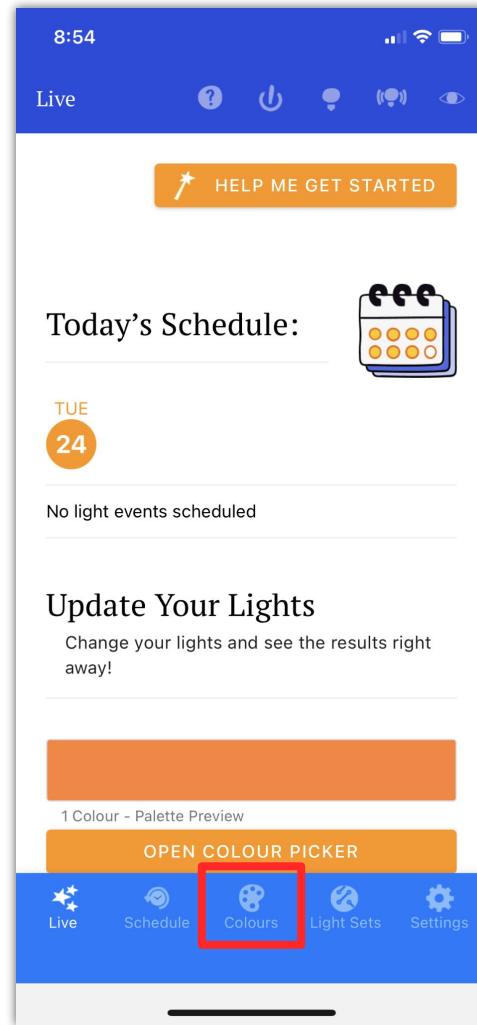
IMPORTANT

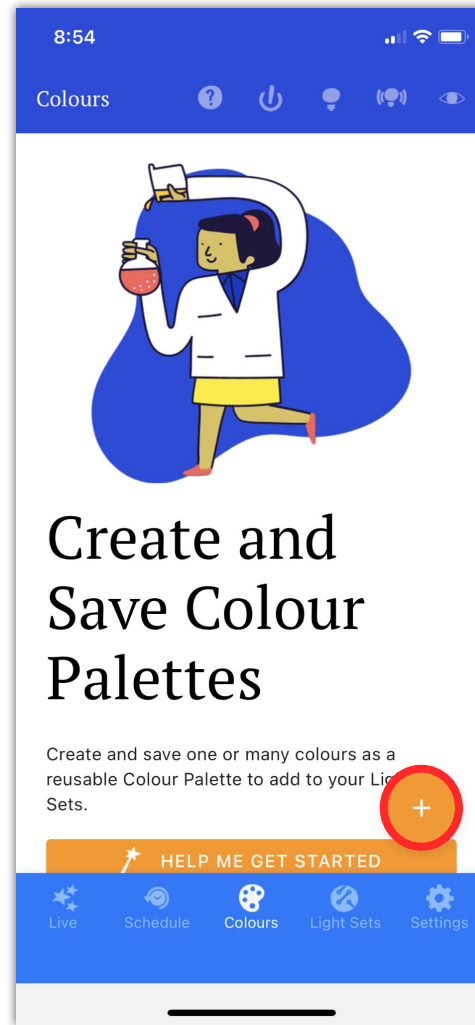

The first step in creating a new colour palette, is to go to the “Colours” tab by selecting it at the bottom of the page.

Once you're on the “Colours” page, click on the “+” button to start creating a new colour palette.

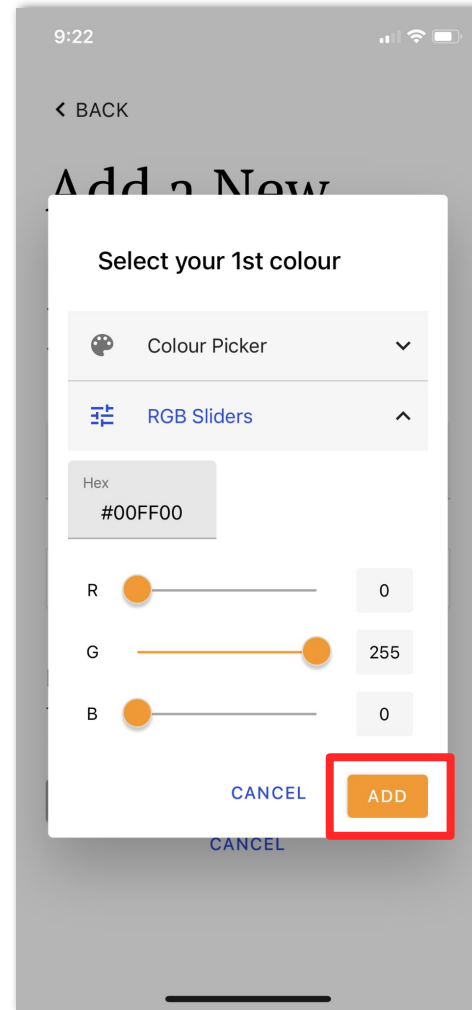

You now can select the first colour that you want in the your new palette.

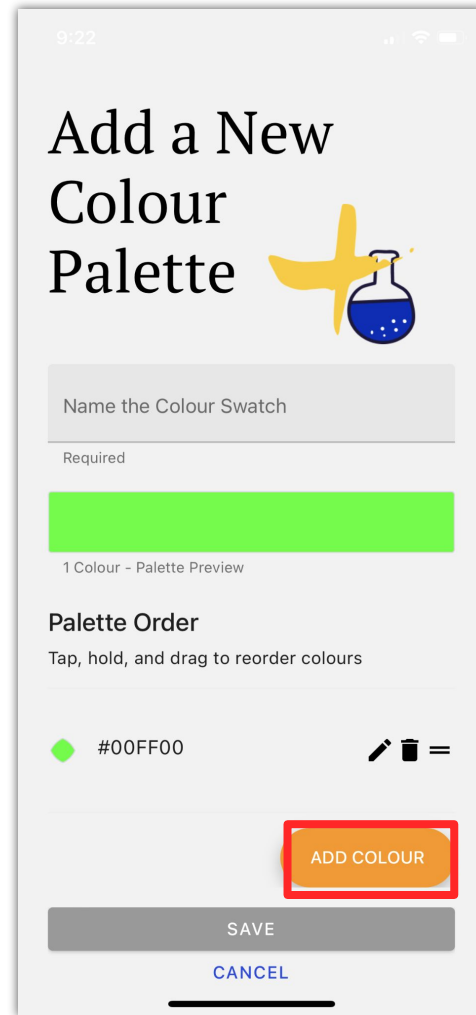
Using either the RGB Sliders or the colour picker, choose your first colour.

For this example, we chose green by changing the “G” value to 255, and the “R” and “B” values to 0. When finished, Click “Add”.

Click “ADD COLOUR” to choose another colour for your pattern

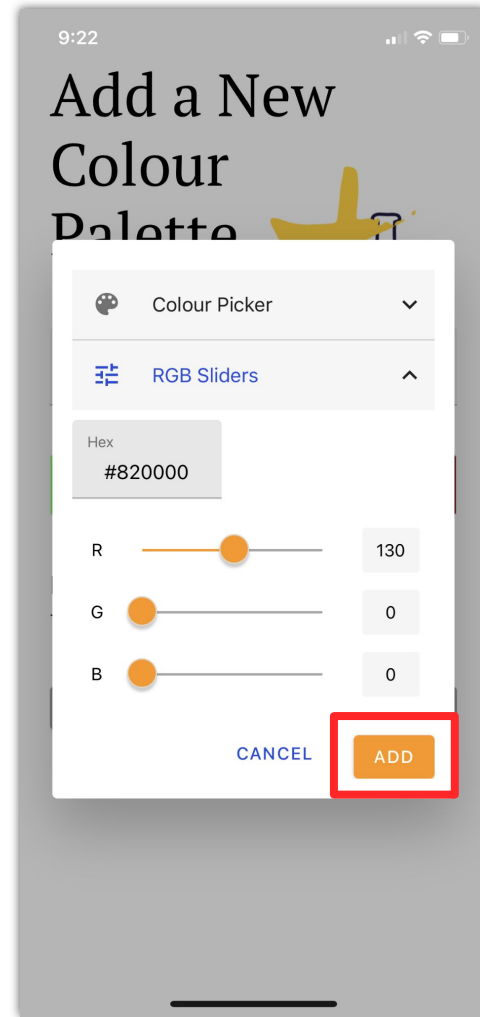

Now we'll create a "dim" red by setting the "G" & "B" values to "0" and the "R" value to less than 255 (the brightest the Red can be).

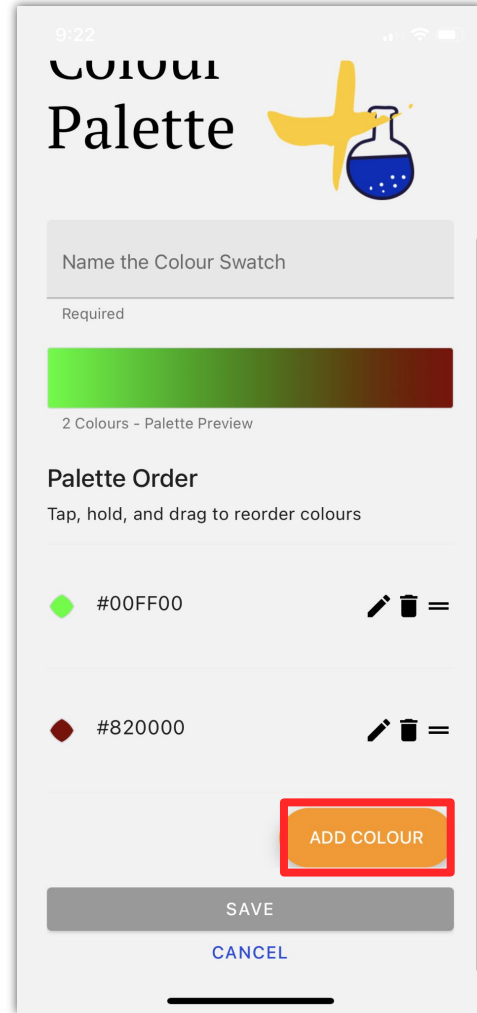
The closer you set the colour value to "0" the dimmer that colour will be.

When you're done, click the "ADD" button.

Click “ADD COLOUR” to choose the final colour for your pattern

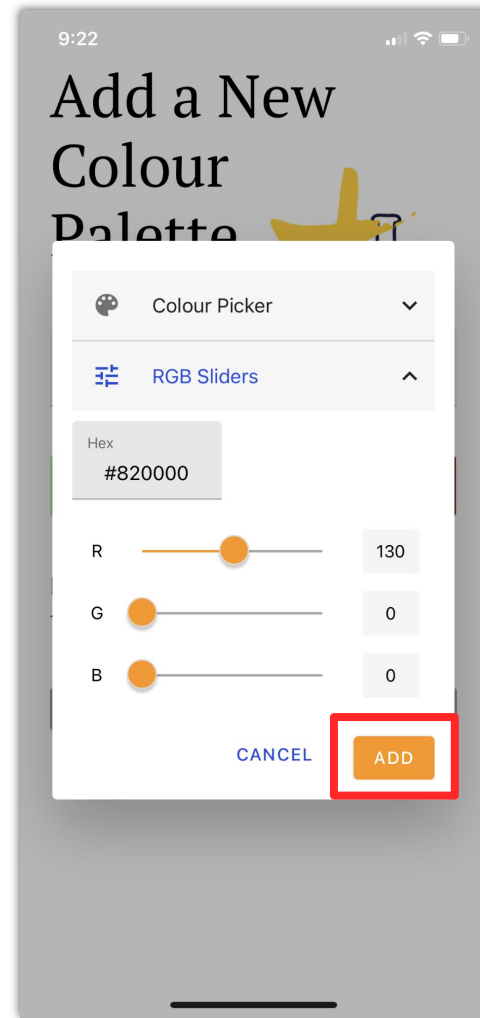

The final colour will be another “dim” red, using the same RGB numbers as before:

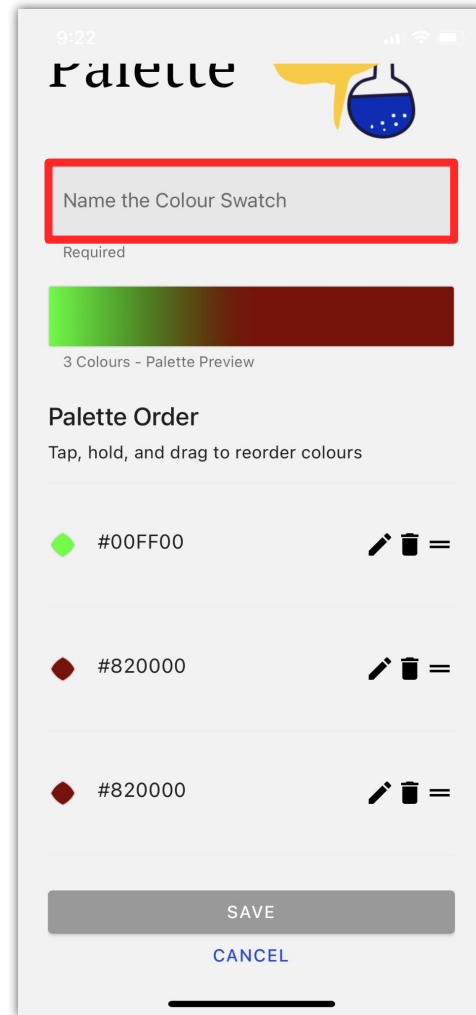
- R-130
- G-0
- B-0.

Then click “ADD”.



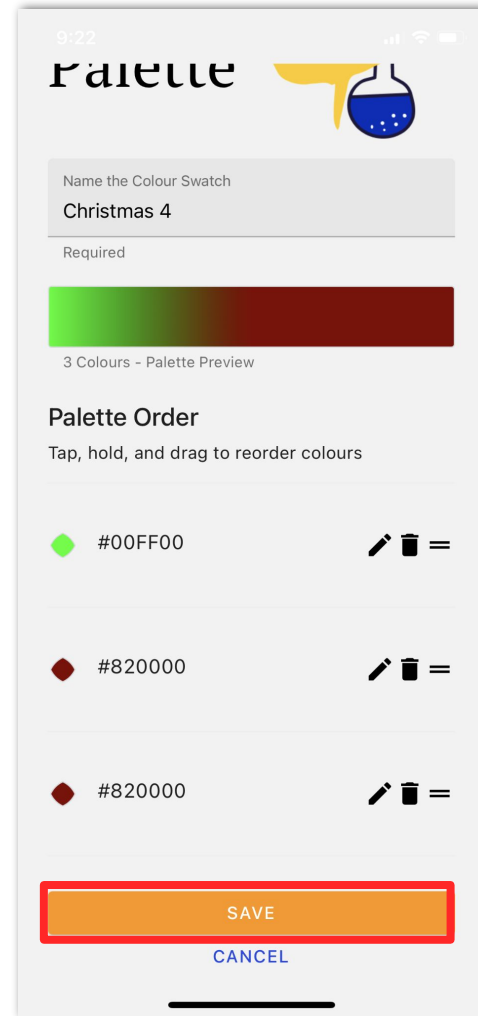

Now that you have chosen all the colours for your new colour palette, give it a name in the “Name the Colour Switch” box.

Scroll down to the bottom of the page and click “SAVE”.
